



Setting up courts

You may have noticed that we have remarked the lawn and set hoop positions for 2×10^{-2} x full sized or 3×3^{4} sized courts.

Please remember that all hoops are numbered and that it is important that they are placed in the correct holes (numbered in the order of play) and the right way round. On the 2 court layout the hoop numbers face the road, and on the 3 court layout they face the pavilion.

If in doubt please ask a member of the committee or someone in the know. Full instructions will be prepared and posted on the equipment cupboard doors.
